Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- I waited for my turn whilst playing a game at home
- I shared my toys with my brother/sister
- I talked about how I was feeling
- I was kind to my brother/sister when I realised they were sad
- I spoke in a quiet voice and didn't shout
- I helped Mummy/Daddy make a cake/sandwich
- I made a new friend
- I showed resilience and perseverance when something was tricky for me
- I got dressed/undressed by myself
- I made a healthy snack/meal

Communication and language Development

- I followed instructions i.e got dressed when asked, was able to follow more than 1 instruction
- I asked questions about why things happen
- I spoke with confidence to someone new
- I made up a story and told my Mummy/Daddy
- I dressed up and acted out a film/book/song
- I used new words when I was talking
- I listened to a story and talked about what happened

<u>Literacy</u>

- I made up a story all by myself
- I recognised the sound..... in my story book
- I recognised the word..... in my story book
- I wrote my name (first and surname)
- I wrote a story by myself
- I made my own book/list/instructions
- I wrote a thank you/birthday card for my friend
- I read my favourite story
- I read a road sign
- I sounded out the word c-a-t by myself

<u>Mathematics</u>

- I played a board game and counted each space correctly
- I recognised the numbers on the dice
- I found something in the
- shape of a on the way home
- I wrote numbers to 10/20.....
- I can use objects to match the value to a number
- I wrote some addition number sentences
- I wrote some take away number sentences
- I can recall numbers that make 10
- I can make a repeating pattern
- I know the number on my front door

Physical Development

- I stayed in my own bed all night
- I can swim without armbands/float
- I won a swimming certificate
- I used a knife and fork at dinner
- I rode my bike without stabilizers
- I zipped up my coat
- I can write the sounds......
- I can balance
- I made a den/camp
- I used my knife for cutting my food
- I brush my teeth for 3 minutes

Understanding the World

- I can talk about the changes I can see around me i.e weather, people, animals
- I can see the difference and similarity between.....things/people/cultures
- I can lay the table to dinner
- I can load the washing machine
- I can use the TV remote control
- I can use a computer/ipad/tablet

Expressive Arts and Design

- I can sing a song/rhyme/poem
- I can make music using instruments
- I can mix 2 colours to make a new colour
- I can make my own musical instrument
- I can design and make my own.....
- I can make up my own story and act it out using role play
- I can dress up and be my favourite singer/ book character..
- I can make up my own dance
- I can move to different types of music
- I can make a puppet and tell a story
